Torrington Attorney John R. Logan Receives CBA Distinguished Professional Service Award

NEW BRITAIN, CT (June 13, 2012)—The Connecticut Bar Association (CBA) presented the 2012 John Eldred Shields Distinguished Professional Service Award to Torrington attorney John R. Logan at its 2012 Annual Dinner on June 11.

This award recognizes a member of the CBA who has performed outstanding service to the Association that has benefitted fellow CBA members, the legal profession and the community at large.

Logan, a partner with Logan & Mencuccini LLP in Torrington, is a trial lawyer whose practice involves the representation of negligence victims and criminal defendants. He has been an active member of the Association since the 1980s, and served for ten years as Litchfield County's sole elected representative to the CBA's Board of Governors and House of Delegates and was treasurer of the Association in 2004-2005. A frequent lecturer on ethics, Attorney Logan is currently chair of the CBA's Committee on Professional Ethics, and has served on or chaired multiple other CBA committees and task forces through the years. He is the co-chair of the Executive Director Compensation and Review Committee, serves as a member of the executive committee of the Litigation Section, ex officio, and is a member of the Criminal Law Section.

In the citation for his award, Logan was lauded as having "a relentless commitment to the CBA [that] has enriched and improved our Association. You are known for your wisdom, guidance, and counsel to a generation of CBA Presidents whose trust in your judgment is legendary."

Outside the CBA, Logan is a member of the Connecticut Bar Foundation's Board of Directors and sits as chair of its Audit Committee. He is a sustaining life fellow of the James W. Cooper Fellows Program, a member of the Litchfield County Bar Association, a past president and current member of the Torrington Rotary Club, a member and past treasurer of the Avon Democratic Town Committee, a past chair and past treasurer of the Torrington Democratic Town Committee, a past member of the Torrington Ethics Commission, a past member of the Avon Inland Wetlands Commission, and a former member of the adjunct faculty at Northwest Community College teaching political science. He is a member of the Torrington Country Club, the Golf Club of Avon, the Northwest Chamber of Commerce, a incorporator for the Catholic Family Charities, and a member of the UConn advisory committee for the Torrington campus. He lives in Avon with his wife and children.
